

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

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Educational Capacity: The challenge

- Currently, 646 RN to BSN programs are available nationwide, including more than 400 offered at least partially online.
- 2010 to 2011, enrollments increased by 15.8 percent, marking the ninth consecutive year of increases in RN to BSN programs.
- 2012 preliminary data shows a 13.4 percent increase in RN to BSN enrollments, slightly down from the prior year

Capacity and Access: A National Partner

Western Governors University

- National Scope
 - Students in all 50 states
- Prerequisites
 - Regionally accredited University
 - "Prerequisites" can be taken after enrollment
- Alternative faculty model
 - Faculty roles allow for better scalability
 - Asynchronous learning

Contributing to the goal

Outcomes – Graduates as of October 2012

- RN to BSN 2,265
- MSN 458
- BSN (Prelicensure) 46

Total contribution to date toward 80% by 2020 2,769

Enrollment – 400/month 2013 RN to BSN enrollment projection = 4,800

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National enrollments help move the needle toward 80 by 20

WGU Educational Collaboratives

- HCA Hospital System experienced a 64% increase in RN to BSN enrollments in 7 months
- Cedars Sinai Medical Center had a 223% increase in RN to BSN enrollments in the same 7 months

All hospital and community college partners report that multiple options are needed to change the culture by creating a critical mass of enrolled RNs

Access challenges for working nurses

- 1. Cost 65% (N= 298)
- 2. Doesn't fit my schedule 38% (N=176)
- 3. Don't have time 33% (N=153)

Working nurses surveyed about barriers to returning to school TX, FL & CA (N= 456)

Affordable and Accessible





- Affordability
 - Low tuition, no increases in five years
 - Fixed fees for books etc.
- Financial access
 - FFA access
- Physical access
 - Online
 - Asynchronous

Scalable and Flexible

- Self pacing and asynchronous = flexible
- Monthly enrollment = flexible and scalable

I have been a WGU student since May 2010. I love it because it fits my schedule, I can study at ANY time. I love the price, and the fact you can accelerate in any term without paying for additional units/credits! And, it is self-paced within each term.

Challenges from a National University's perspective

- State Action Coalitions
 - Involved in WA, TX, UT, IN
 - Not organized with state-specific resources
- Data sharing
 - Data is collected and organized by program, not state
 - Ability to contribute data to each state is resource-intensive
- Meaningful engagement
 - State relationships aren't possible for 50 states
 - Contributing to the solution with graduates is!!
