

Project Coordinator Position Announcement

The Wisconsin Action Coalition, led by the Wisconsin Center for Nursing (WCN) and the Rural Wisconsin Health Cooperative (RWHC), is seeking a nursing leader as the Project Coordinator for a Robert Wood Johnson Foundation® (RWJF) State Implementation Project (SiP) grant.

This key leadership position will provide planning, implementation and evaluation for the Wisconsin Action Coalition RWJF SiP grant, *“Taking the LEAD for Nursing in Wisconsin: Leadership, Educational Advancement and Diversity,”* beginning February 1, 2013.

The project is designed to advance the recommendations of the IOM Report, *“The Future of Nursing: Leading Change, Advancing Health,”* in the state of Wisconsin.

Key Qualifications:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing required
- Master’s Degree in Nursing, or other applicable graduate degree preferred
- Successful project and/or grant management experience
- Demonstrated ability in collaborative leadership, coalition-building and facilitation
- Research, data collection and/or outcomes measurement experience
- Exceptional oral and written communication skills

Reporting, Compensation & Duration: This position reports to the Executive Director of the Wisconsin Center for Nursing. The position is envisioned as a 0.5FTE position. The salary is negotiable, commensurate based upon experience, and will include pro-rated benefits.

The Project commences February 1, 2013 and ends January 31, 2015. It is expected that the successful applicant will attend the national conference of the Future of Nursing™ Campaign for Nursing, Washington DC, February 27-March 1, 2013, as required by RWJF, and will be supported with SiP grant funding.
