Risk Intervention for Student Enhancement (RISE) Program:

The RISE Program is available for all students considered "at-risk" for being unsuccessful in the traditional baccalaureate of science in nursing program. Students are determined to be "at-risk" if they have to repeat a nursing course. The purpose of RISE is to offer individualized support for these students within a structured program overseen by a nursing faculty member, the RISE Coordinator.

- Students are enrolled in a RISE course for a minimum of 2 semesters.
- The primary focus of the program is to model for students how to be accountable and responsible within their nursing courses to become successful in school and essentially in their nursing careers.
- Assignments are structured towards fostering improved time management, study habits and testing skills.
- The RISE Coordinator becomes the students' permanent advisor in the future sequencing of classes until graduation.
- Beginning Fall 2015, all RISE students will be paired with a recent nursing alumni to be mentored until they subsequently graduate from the nursing program.

Center for Best Practices in Teaching and Learning

A Center for Best Practices in Teaching and Learning (CBPTL) was established in 2012 at the College of Nursing. The CBPTL has a number of functions, one of which focuses on student mentoring.

- The CBPTL is looking for ways to introduce peer mentoring into our program, beginning as early as Fall 2016.
