

Dr. Haviland is the Advanced Practice Provider Manager of Professional Development at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center (MSK) in New York City. She maintains her clinical practice as a nurse practitioner on the Supportive Care Inpatient Medicine Service. Her prior clinical experience includes Pulmonary Medicine Service, Surgical Advanced Care Step-down, Pediatric Hemophilia, Pediatric Cardiac Intensive Care, and Cardiac Surgery. Dr. Haviland has published research on chronically critically ill patients with cancer and cancer care for sexual and gender minority patients. During her tenure at MSK, she has chaired the Advanced Practice Provider (APP) Professional Development Council, the LGBTQ Clinical Advisory Council, and is a member of the Ethics Committee, the Nursing IRB Review Protocol Committee, and the Global Healthcare Disparities Council. She has led program development in a variety of areas including the initiation of a consultation service for LGBTQ patients at MSK, a career pathway program for APPs, participation of APPs in a hospital-wide simulation program, and numerous ongoing educational activities for APPs.

Dr. Haviland earned her PhD from the Medical University of South Carolina (MUSC) in November 2019. During her tenure at MUSC, she received the *Ruth Chamberlin Scholarship Award* for the programs' top application to entry, served as the elected PhD Student Representative for two years, and was a member of the MUSC's Honor Council.
