GAPS Assessment

- Discussion with Nurse Educators at Potential Institutions
- Potential Students Records review
- Commitment from institutions to release students 1 day a week





Criteria for Selection of Student and Faculty

Students:

Bachelor of Science Degree and or Masters Degree in Nursing

GPA

Commitment to serve as preceptor or faculty





Criteria for Faculty

- Eligible for appointment to Lehman College and or faculty of City University of NY
- Experts in Content Taught
- Time commitment to program





Gap Program Curriculum

- Theory course in Nurse's Role in Professional Development (3 credits)
- Clinical Course (3 credits)
- Areas Covered in both courses





Outcomes

- 10 persons completed the program
- All awarded the 6 college credits
- Credits accepted by Adelphi, Hunter, SUNY Stoney Brook and Lehman
- Masters prepared students hired as adjuncts at Adelphi, Lehman
- Three BS only matriculated into masters program at Lehman and completed the degrees and 2 hired as adjuncts. 2 continue as adjuncts in maternal child
- 1. masters prepared student currently an assistant professor at Lehman College
